Some of the girls participated in both Take Action Projects!

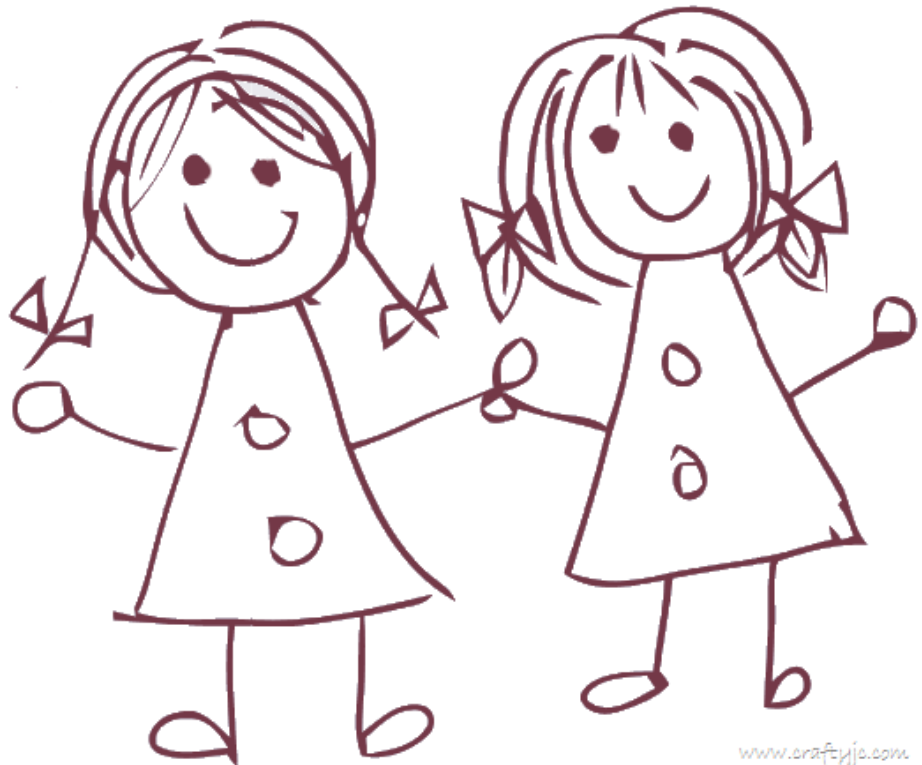


MAKING FRIENDS
